

Whereas, the Peru Public Library District is a tax-supported public library; and

Whereas, people residing within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Library District pay taxes to support the library, and paying no additional fee to be eligible to receive a Peru Library card; and

Whereas, *16 Illinois Compiled Statutes 16/30-55.60* stipulates "a person residing outside of a public library service area must apply for a nonresident card at the public library located closest to the person's principal residence;" and

Whereas, the Board of Library Trustees of the Peru Public Library District participates in the nonresident reciprocal borrowing program of the regional library system and issues nonresident cards for the fiscal year beginning 1 July 2017 and ending 30 June 2018;

Therefore, the Board of Library Trustees of the Peru Public Library District, La Salle County, Illinois, ordains:

Section 1. Individuals residing beyond the jurisdictional boundaries of the Peru Public Library District whose closest public library is the Peru Public Library District, and not residing within the boundaries of another public library, and owning no taxable property within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Peru Public Library District, may purchase a non-resident fee card for the price of \$100.00 a year. This fee is calculated on the General Mathematical Formula [23 Administrative Code 3050.60(a)]. The fee entitles the entire family to use the Peru Public Library District.

Section 2. Individuals residing beyond the jurisdictional boundaries of the Peru Public Library District, but owning (as an individual, a partner, the principle stockholder, or other joint owner) taxable property within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Peru Public Library District, may obtain one (1) non-resident library card without payment of the non-resident fee by presenting their most recent tax bill for that taxable property. The privileges and use of the Library District are extended one individual non-resident for each parcel of taxable property. Each non-resident library card issued pursuant to this section is limited to the exclusive use of the individual whose name appears on its face.

Section 3: A valid non-resident library card issued by the Peru Public Library District pursuant to this Ordinance accords a non-resident library cardholder all the services the Library District provides to its residents, including reciprocal borrowing privileges.


Section 4: The regional library system is notified within 30 days of this Ordinance's adoption, stating (a) the Ordinance's effective date, (b) time frame covered by this Ordinance, and (c) the adopted fee formula.
